David Kelly

David Kelly is pastor at Primera Iglesia Bautista (First Baptist Church), which meets at Oak Hill Baptist Church in Columbia Heights. David recently replaced GracePoint's own Delmar IntVeld, who ministered there as a long-term interim pastor. David grew up as an MK in Ecuador, where he met his wife RoxAnn when she was on a short term missions trip. They later served in Ecuador for some time, part of which David spent in the role of church planter. The Hispanic community faces many challenges,



such as housing and employment instability, and those challenges are reflected in the church and its' ministries. David recently shared with the missions committee about the church's ministry, including goals and current programs (including AWANNA). He shared how important it is to have ministry partners like GracePoint to help provide stability, and how much that support is appreciated. Nils Friberg also visited Primera Iglesia Bautista in January, and was able to use his Portuguese to (somewhat) navigate the language barrier. Nils was encouraged by what he experienced that Sunday.
