## GLOBAL PARTNER OF THE WEEK David Kelly

David Kelly is pastor at Primera Iglesia Evangélica Bautista (First Baptist Evangelical Church), which meets at Oak Hill Baptist Church in Columbia Heights. David grew up as an MK in Ecuador, where he met his wife RoxAnn when she was on a short term missions trip. They later served in Ecuador for some time, including church planting. David recently replaced GracePoint's own Delmar IntVeld, who ministered there for 23 years! Many from the church joined GracePoint friends in mourning the recent passing of Delmar, and celebrating his ministry. The Hispanic community faces many challenges (such as housing and employment instability), and those challenges are reflected in the church and its' ministries. David shared with the missions committee how important it is to have ministry partners like GracePoint to help provide stability. David asks for prayer for the ALPHA ministry, which will take the Gospel into many homes where some members do not yet understand the Gospel. David writes: "My passion in ministry is to serve the growing Hispanic population by presenting Christ through a clear message, building up a welcoming church as the body of Christ where new people can be received and nurtured, and by equipping each person to be active in their call of making disciples."
